# *General Information*

**Program Changes:** NSSA and the CCFSA reserve the right to change this Program without recourse or protest. We also reserve the right to refuse any entry or withdraw any competitor who annoys, endangers, or interferes in any manner with the harmony of the shoot.

**Practice Fields:** International Skeet Practice will be available on Thursday, Sept 14<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m.

**Safety Requirements:** Eye and Ear protection is mandatory. Competitors assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the CCFSA grounds.

**Liability:** All risks of accident are assumed by the individuals present on the shooting grounds. The OSSA and CCFSA are not responsible for injury incurred by any individual.

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be current members of the NSSA. Applications for membership will be available at registration.

**Rules & Regulations:** USA Shooting Rules will apply. 24 gram ammunition is required. Reloads will be permitted and may be weighed and checked. No shot larger than 7 ½. A jury will be selected prior to the Preliminary Event and will be posted. NSSA age requirements for concurrent events will apply.

**Registering:** Registration 4:00-6:00 p.m. Thursday, 10:00 a.m.-noon. Friday, and 8:00-9:00 a.m. Saturday. All entries are final. No refunds for withdrawals w/o emergency medical excuse.

**Shoot-Offs:** Ties for Event #1 will carry over to Event #2 first round.  
Special Final 6 Shoot-off for Juniors at conclusion of Event #2  
Top six open finals will be held at the conclusion of Sunday's shooting.  
Ties for both Class and Concurrent Events will be broken by long run from the rear.

**Flankers:** Competitors will be required to serve as flankers for both the Preliminary and Main Events.

**Classes:** Competitors will be classed according to their NSSA International Skeet or USA Shooting Classification, whichever is higher.
