

GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is sanctioned by and will be conducted under the direction of the OHIO STATE SKEET ASSOCIATION (OSSA) and under the rules of the NATIONAL SKEET SHOOTING ASSOCIATION (NSSA).

Ohio shooters must be members of the OSSA and NSSA. **Advanced registration may be made by calling Bruce Poyer (440) 474-9131** Please preregister and make your reservations for our banquet Saturday evening.

Paid NSSA licensed referees will be used on all fields. Any protest to a referee's decision must be made according to 2008 NSSA protest rules.

Ties for all Gun, Team, Class places, and Concurrents will be shot off. Doubles stations 3, 4 and 5. Miss and out by STATION. If individuals are tied for more than one title, both will be decided in same shoot off. Shoot offs for H.O.A. and H.A.A. shall be with 410 gauge.

Classification will be determined by NSSA Rules. Bring your Classification Card, filled in correctly, up to date, including current averages in all guns. 5 Person team entries must shoot shoulder-to-shoulder but there will be no fees this year. Teams must declare their intention prior to shooting.

Shells of standard make and gauges will be available at the clubhouse. Reloads will be permitted in accordance with NSSA Rules. Six fields will be available and all events will be shot 100 targets per field. Squad starting times will be rigidly adhered to with late arrivals being dropped to the bottom of the entry list if there is room available. There will be no refund in such cases.

The OSSA President solely reserves the right to refuse any entry and to make any change (according to NSSA Rules) deemed necessary to this program.

Participation Pins will be given to Ohio Shooters @registration. Awards or Medals will be given for Event: Champion, Runner-Up; Class: Champion, Second, Third (AA, A, B, C, D for all and also E for 12 gauge event); Two Man Team: Class I, Class II; Five Man Team: Champions; Concurrents: Sub-Junior, Junior, Triple-Sub, Sub-Sub-Senior, Sub-Senior, Senior, Veteran, Family, Lady, Collegiate, Referee (only 12 ga.), Novice (only 12 ga.). **PINS - OHIO RESIDENTS ONLY**

A shooter must have a minimum average of .94 for an Open Team Triple Sub, Sub Sub Senior and a minimum average of .91 for all concurrents except Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior which must have a minimum average of .83. The Ohio State Skeet H.O.A. Team requires that a shooter meet the Ohio minimums for 12, 20, 28, and 410.

2.) **Age** concurrent are based on the shooter's age on the 1st day of the shooting year (11/1).

3.) When more than one person have identical scores for the fifth team position, the team is expanded to include six shooters (ie., the five highest scores).
